4. At the case management conference the court may make pretrial orders, including the following:
 - a. An order establishing a discovery schedule.
 - b. An order referring the case to arbitration.
 - c. An order transferring the case to limited jurisdiction or justice court.
 - d. An order dismissing fictitious defendants.
 - e. An order scheduling exchange of expert witness information.
 - f. An order setting subsequent conferences and the trial date.
 - g. Other orders to achieve the goals of the Trial Court Reduction Act (Gov. Code, § 68600 et seq.)
