AFFECTING COURT OPERATIONS AND COVID-19 EMERGENCY POLICIES

I. **FINDINGS**

A. In accordance with, and in response to changes in COVID-19 guidelines and regulations by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

II. ORDER

- A. Effective March 28, 2022, and unless otherwise required by a federal, state, or local public health mandate, individuals will no longer be required to wear a face mask while inside Glenn County Superior court facilities. In line with the CDPH's strong recommendation that all persons, regardless of vaccination status, continue to mask while in indoor public settings, individuals may voluntarily wear a face mask while inside Court facilities.
- B. Access to Court facilities is limited to individuals attesting that they are not currently sick, have not recently tested positive for COVID-19 and are within the isolation timeframes as outlined by the CDPH, and re not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms as outlined by the CDPH. Current entry requirements will be posted at the entrance of each Court facility. Any individual entering the courthouse must be in compliance with posted conditions prior to entry. If any individual is not able to comply with the entry conditions, they shall call the Glenn County Superior Court at (530) 934-6446.
- The General Order Re: Implementation of Emergency Relief Authorized Pursuant to GC68115 by Chair of Judicial Council issued by this Court on April 1 of 2020, remains in full force and effect until April 30, 2022, upon which date it is rescinded.
- D. Unless otherwise authorized by statute, California Rules of Court, or Glenn County Superior Court Local Rules, all other COVID-19 emergency orders are hereby rescinded.
