## Multiple Offenses

In the case of multiple offenses against a single defendant, bail is based on the total of the bail for each separate offense. A separate offense is an offense not subject to Penal Code § 654 - i.e., an offense, which is not just a different statement of the same crime. [Common Example: suspect enters Safeway and steals something: suspect has a prior theft conviction, so suspect is charged with PC §§ $459.5 \& 496$. This is § 654. If an individual is charged with multiple offenses, then those not subject to § 654 shall be aggregated.
